Using the Library

The library is free to join. Register as a library member online at <https://library.iniva.org> or please ask when you visit. Short-stay visitors are welcome to sign-in to look around the library, but are required to register to use the collections.

The library is open to the public for reference, research and browsing. Items may not be borrowed.

We ask all visitors to store bags, coats and jackets in the free lockers provided on the ground floor. These items will not be admitted into the library. Rivington Place reception staff will be happy to advise you.

On arrival, sign the visitors' book at the library enquiry desk.

To care for and preserve the collections, it is important that no food or drink (except water) is brought into the library.

The library is a quiet study space, so please turn your mobile phone to silent.

Please do not re-shelve books or journals; leave them on the trolley or on the study tables.

Free Wi-fi is available; please ask for the password.

Ask library staff for access to photocopying facilities. Copying should be within the permitted limits of the copyright legislation; see the guidelines next to the photocopier. Donations toward photocopying costs help us to maintain the service.

Portable scanners or other copying equipment should not be brought into the library.
